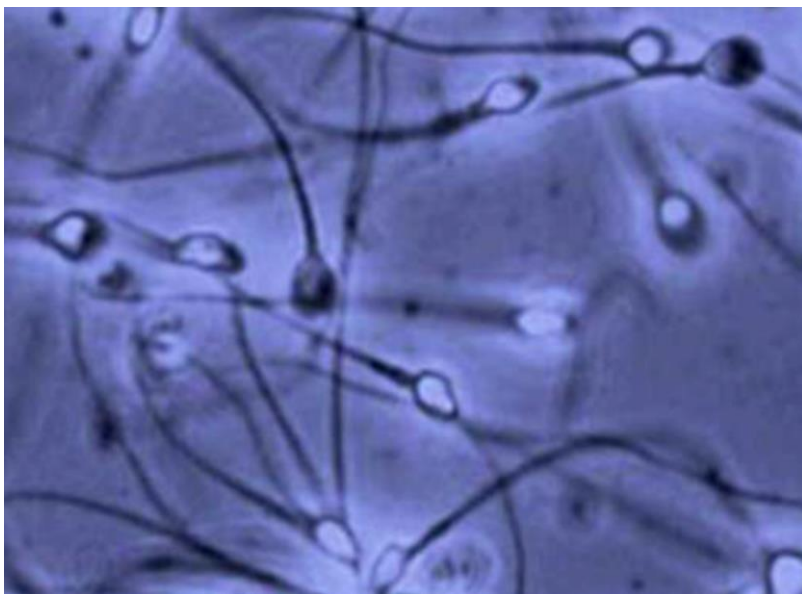


Forensic Training

Sexual Offence Investigations

Course

- One-day course run at Alecto's laboratory and training facility in Watchfield and delivered by qualified instructors
- Designed for forensic scientists, crime scene investigators, managers and other related professionals
- Provides a comprehensive overview of the forensic investigation of sexual offences



Structure

- The course is presented through lectures, interactive classroom discussions, and practical exercises

Content

- Considers the various evidence types commonly found in sexual offence cases and discusses the associated chemical tests
- Understand the knowledge and procedures that take place during a forensic medical examination in order to consider body fluid persistence times, best practices for recovery and packaging of evidence, and how certain actions can result in the potential loss of evidence or cross-contamination
- Factors affecting the formulation of a forensic strategy will be explored, including an emphasis on conditioning information in relation to case studies
- Participants should expect to discuss explicit aspects of sexual activity and scenarios based on case studies

- Understand how to recover, process, and set a forensic strategy to maximise the recovery of evidence in sexual offence investigations
- Comprehend the examination process that takes place in the laboratory
